

Fall 2022 Kentucky All State Golf Team

High School golf coaches, players and parents,

The 2023 All-State Team Criteria is here. We have made some changes to the 2023 season's format and believe it will again help select representatives deserving to be named an All-State Team member.

The All-State Committee discussions continued to be centered on two main objectives:

- 1.To enhance the standing of high school sanctioned golf in our state and surrounding region.
- 2.To improve the process of determining and recognizing the best high school golfers in the state.

The committee will utilize the following to achieve our stated objectives.

*A points system that puts a premium on good, consistent performances throughout the regular season and postseason.

*Minimum standards for competitions to more accurately gauge the level of talent across the state.

***** 2023 Clarification on Committee Authority *****

"The All State Committee will make the final decision as to a player's eligibility to hold a spot on the All-State Team. "

Please be aware that the 2022 All-State Team Criteria are required only for events wishing to be considered an "All-State" points event.

The 2022 "All-State Criteria", "Tournament Submission and Reporting Procedures", and "Frequently Asked Questions" are included on separate links this year.

2022 All-State Committee

"The All-State Team Committee was reorganized in 2014. It is made up of boys and girls high school golf coaches, persons from amateur and professional golf organizations serving our state, and the golf community at large."

Fall 2023 All State Team Criteria

1. All tournament hosts must be KGCA Members.

Tournament information, such as the information flier, event date & location and contact information, must be submitted to All-State Committee to be eligible for points consideration. Host schools must be members of KGCA for events to be listed on the tournament schedule. Please refer to the tournament submission and reporting procedures for more information

2. Invitational tournaments must be at least 18-hole competitions.

Due to the virtual impossibility of an equitable means of shortening events, the committee has decided that events not completing eighteen holes will not receive a points distribution. The original number of players starting an event will be what is used for the tier ranking. Any player that finishes the 18 holes will be eligible for points. Event (All 18) must be completed in 24 hours from the start, or it will be considered a wash and no points will be awarded.

3. Highest seven (7) point totals earned will be used in the regular season points tally.

If a player chooses to play in more than seven events, he or she may do so, but remember, only the highest seven point totals will be used in the regular season tally.

****Note:** The KGCA All State Championship will NOT count as a regular season event. It will be counted separately, just like the KHSAA Regional Tournament and KHSAA State Tournament***

4. Minimum yardage for tournaments based on par:

- Par 72 or more - Boys 6500 yds & Girls 5400 yds
- Par 71 - Boys 6350 yds & Girls 5250 yds
- Par 70 or less - Boys 6200 yds & Girls 5100 yds

Tournaments not meeting the yardage requirement must be played from the maximum yardage allowable or the event will be subject to a one-tier drop on the points schedule.

5. Competitions will receive a "Tier" rating based on the number of scorecards submitted.

Disqualifications and withdrawals due to illness or injury will be counted as completed rounds. No-shows or withdrawals prior to the start of play will not be considered. Out of state participants included for Tier ranking must also be included in the results, but All State Points are not awarded to out of state participants.

6. Qualifying tournaments for KGCA All State championship must be completed by September 9, 2023 have results turned in by 1:00 pm on Sunday, September 10, 2023.

7. Regional Tournament managers should submit tournament information by September 11, 2023.

Please refer to the tournament submission and reporting procedures for more information.

8. The All-State Points Report is due within 48 hours of event completion.

If information is not returned by 48 hours after completion, the tournament will be marked as LATE on the KGCA Scoreboard page. If scores are not posted on time, the tournament may be assessed an additional fee to post the tournament for next season.

9. Boys and Girls All-State Team members and Mr. and Ms Golf will be chosen as follows: Mr. and Ms. Golf: Individual Points Leader*

*Ties for Mr and Ms Golf decided by highest combined points in KHSAA State Championship and KGCA All State Championship

"PLEASE NOTE: Individual State High School Champion and KGCA All State Champion will automatically make the 1st Team even if they do not finish in the Top 10 in the Point Standings.

First Team: Positions 1-10 in Points (+ties)

Second Team: Positions 11-20 in Points(+ties)
