Vincent Hamilton Memorial All State Championships

The Kentucky Golf Coaches Association is honored to announce the All State Championships, held in honor of Vincent Hamilton, who was a great contributor to High School golf in Kentucky.

This will be a two-day tournament for both boys and girls consisting of the 15 top ranked teams in the State and the top 21 individuals not on those teams. These will be determined by use of the All State rankings through September 14th of this coming year. Since every All State Tournament tracks individuals by points, it is very easy from the paperwork to assign the exact points for the teams as well. This will give us a team list, just like the current individual list, of teams and where they stand. The teams will be ranked along with the individuals as points are tallied, and will be updated weekly to be posted through the KGCA website, www.kygca.org.

This will be a one of a kind event in Kentucky High School golf. The tournament will be held in Lexington at the University Club, utilizing both the Big Blue and Wildcat courses, for both days, with the premier players in the State competing. We want to continue to push what has always been an outstanding sport to even greater heights. In keeping with the mission of the Kentucky Golf Coaches Association, we will emphasize character, honesty, and ethical behavior to bring the best of the best together to compete. This is an additional step to grow the game of High School Golf as well as to allow the KGCA have a little part in the growth of the individuals, their coaches, and families. We will offer more All State points than any other event during the high school season, and want to make this the premier event to have an intentional impact on not only High School golf, but also to all golf in the State.
