

Kentucky Golf Coaches Association Meeting Minutes August 18, 2019

Meeting was called to order by Kevin Mims at 7:30 pm via Go To Meeting

Treasurer Update/KGCA Tournament Update - Pat Heitz

21 new members in last 10 days. Have paid 3 of 4 scholarships from last year at this point. Still one for \$750 to pay. Pat will get with Karen to help follow up on that one.

Pat will send out update after meeting. He and Kevin have developed budgets for both tournaments. There should be a good profit, nearly \$8000 on the tournament on Sept 28th.

Preliminary budget on the Elite All State Tournament should be coming out in next day or two.

All State Reporting

Kellie has been asked by several people if a second team in an event can both earn points. Discussion ensued from several people. Several have seen multiple teams from the same school earning points and awards, including St X at the KIT.

The question is if a player not on the top 5 of a team can earn points. Michael asked, what if the sixth man has more points than others, can they play as an individual. Butch has said this can be done if they count as two KHSAA tournaments.

Committee Reports

All State Elite Tournament

\$6500 so far in donations. Kevin is still looking for another \$4000 to come. Kelly has talked to the Gaunce family and they are planning to give \$2000. He is also getting information to Eric Straub for some additional funds in his part of the state.

Flags - Kellie has talked to a place in Glasgow, and can get flags for \$11-12 printed per flag. They will be looking into that more closely with the chosen logo. She should have a solid price by the middle of the week.

Tee Gifts - Pat has talked to Davis Boland, and he is working on a hybrid headcover, and thinks he can do that for \$15 or less. Green and Gold for boys, Blue and White for girls.

Logos - Kevin and Pat referenced the logos sent out this week with meeting agenda. Karen asked if we could use our logo. Kellie asked if she could mock up a few with what we like.

Question was how to keep it from getting too busy.

Kevin asked to have everyone email top three choices to him, using our official logo. Pat will have a mock up of that made to send out.

Banner with KGCA and Golf House Logo - will need that. They will be doing marking, reporting and scoring. Pat asked if we need to get other sponsors on the banner as well. They will look at that.

Press - Golf House will start getting information out, we need to do that as well. Chris will start getting preliminary information out to major press in the state.

College Coaches - Need to be contacting; Kevin will have Brent start working on this, as he has contacts.

They would like coaches to bring their own water for players, but the course will be selling breakfast and concessions set up around the course.

Pat will work on parking for coaches by the pavillion.

Kellie clarified that carts will be available for team coaches.

Scholarship Committee tabled until next meeting.

Hall of Fame Committee

Discussion has been held by email on number of honorees for this year and categories

Consensus has been for the first year to honor the 5 individuals discussed previously, Marty Donlon, Mike Harris, Leslie Bender, Marcus Camacho and Andy Oder.

We will need to work on a plaque to place at Golf House, and what we want to give to those honored.

Should we do this on Saturday or Sunday at All State tournament?

Will continue to work to finalize qualifications for coming years and number of nominees per year.

Proposal passed unanimously.

New Business

Kevin clarified that there were problems with the email accounts that held up All State Points. Chris and Brad are almost done posting.

Chris proposed a new scoring tracker to allow coaches to post scores and we can average them. This will not be at any cost to them, and schools are not required to post. Will send out through KHSAA list to let schools post.

This would be a new service for member coaches. They can turn in a spreadsheet of their tournament scores for up to 10 players every 1-2 weeks in an excel form that we can enter into a master spreadsheet to calculate tournament averages.

By using the spreadsheet, to copy and paste this should not take much time on our part.

This will be posted on the site for all coaches to see. But in order to post, you need to be a member.

This will help regional managers to see averages through all tournaments played that are turned in.

This will also be used to determine the nominees for the All Region Team at the end of the year. By having this, we can use the top 10 averages for players in each region, plus the top 5 finishers at the Regional Tournament, and any players from the region in the top 100 All State points, up to a maximum of 15 nominees per region.

7. Coaches will not be required to use this, but it can be a nice tool to see how teams in the region stack up together, and to better judge players from around the region they might not see playing as much.

8. This would be completely up to coaches to turn in scores; we would not be going through every tournament to look up player scores.

9. The form for coaches to use, and the spreadsheet for our use are both ready to go at this time if we want to do this.
